1. Organising Autority

The Organising authorities are the Royal Belgian Sailing Club (RBSC).

2. Governing Rules

The Vivium Sailing Trophy will be governed by:

The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS) and any amendments. The prescriptions of the KBYV/FRBY will apply.

The Class Rules.

The Notice of Race.

The Sailing Instructions.

In case of conflict between languages the English text will prevail.

3. Eligibility and Entry

Open to all Hobie Cat 16 without spi. Each crew member on the boat has to be a current financial member of their National Hobie Cat Association.

All entrants, to be eligible for the Vivium Sailing Trophy, shall: Comply with RRS Appendix 2 – ISAF Eligibility Code. Have a current Public Liability and Third Party Property Insurance policy, including coverage when racing at the venue of the Challenge, of not less than $500.000 \in$ or equivalent for each boat. Any competitor under the age of 18 yrs will be required to obtain parental/guardian consent prior to commencement of the event.

4. Fees

Payment of entry has to be made at registration.

6. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be given at the registration.

7. Venue

The Vivium Sailing Trophy will be held the 14th and 15th august 2010.

The Vivium Sailing Trophy will be sailed in front of the coast of Knokke-Heist.

The Racing Area is the North Sea between Zeebrugge and Knokke-Heist. The Regatta Site is the **RBSC Duinbergen - Zeedijk 430A - B.8301 Knokke-Heist.**

8. Courses and Competition format

The course to sail will be indicate during the briefing. Beach Start (Le Mans), depending on the weather conditions. Fun, along the beach depending on the weather.

9. Penalty system and Protest requirement

The alternative penalty rules RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that the 720° turn shall be replaced by a 360° turn and shall include one tack and one gybe.

10. Scoring

The regatta will be scored as provided in RRS Appendix A4.1 using the Low Point System.

11. Safety regulations

RRS 40 applies at all times while afloat, although flag "Y" will not be displayed. This changes RRS 40.
