NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Race Committee: RBSC

2. Protest Committee: RBSC

3. Rules: RRS 2025-2028, Class Rules and these Sailing Instructions.
Open to all catamarans of the C4, C3 and C1 classes listed in the International Small Catamaran Handicap Rating System, www.schrs.com.
A working mobile phone on board is MANDATORY.

4. Registration & Briefing: Beachclub Duinbergen & Beach Club Het Zoute
Registration: **from 09:30 hrs**
Briefing at 11:30 hrs (course explanation).
Competitors are expected from 12:00 hrs onwards.

5. Course: Long Distance Race: The course will be explained during the briefing.

6. Flags: Flag "G" hoisted, accompanied by one sound signal: boats shall leave the beach.
Flag "Q" (yellow) = class flag for the C4 and C3 classes, and Lasers.
Flag "F18" = class flag for the C1 class.

7. Starting Procedure: "Orange" flag hoisted
AT LEAST 4 MINUTES LATER

- 00:05 "Q" or "F18" flag hoisted
- 00:04 "P" flag (or Black Flag) hoisted
- 00:01 "P" flag (or Black Flag) lowered. One-Minute Rule
- 00:00 Start

A separate start is scheduled for each class (For the lasers if minimum 5 boats).
One start for the C4/C3 classes and one start for the C1 class.
The order of the starts will be decided on the water.

8. Recalls: Individual recall: "X" flag (white square flag with blue cross)
General recall: "First Substitute" (blue-yellow triangular flag)

9. Start Line: Located near the Yellow Marker MOW 2 between the Duinbergen and Het Zoute bases.
Start line between the committee boat displaying an orange flag and the BLACK buoy.
Return Start Line & Finish Line : Will be explained during the briefing.

10. Scoring: Low Point Scoring System.
Long Distance Race, two races sailed (outbound and return): no discard.
Alternative course, windward-leeward course: one discard after 4 races sailed.
Separate results will be published for the C4, C3, C1 and A-Cat classes.



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- 11. Insurance:** Valid third-party liability insurance for each boat is mandatory.
- 12. Safety:** THE FOLLOWING MUST BE CARRIED ON BOARD:
- Life jackets / 1 per person
 - 1 working mobile phone per boat
- 13. Entry Fee:** Double-handed boat €40 / Single-handed boat €30 (Sandwich & drink included)
- 14. Prize Giving:** At Beachclub Duinbergen, as soon as possible after the arrival of the last competitor.
- 15. Risk Statement:** RRS3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, hypothermia or other causes.
- 16. Insurance:** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.
