NOR & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. GOVERNING RULES

The Papy's Race will be governed by:

- The Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and any amendments.
- Open to : all catamarans C3 and C1 classes listed in the Handicap Rating System, www.schrs.com
- A working mobile phone on board is MANDATORY.

THE PAPY'S RACING RULES:

The crew (with a maximum of 3 crewmembers) must have a **combined age over 80 years** as of 8 August 2026. The mammy's crew (with a maximum of 3 crewmembers) must have a combined age over 70 years as of 8 August 2026.

Participants who are dressed entirely in the **theme "Under Construction"** are eligible for the **main prize** of the Delen Papy's Race 2026.

A 20 knots wind limit is foreseen.

2. Registration & Briefing:

Payment of entry has to be made at registration.

Entry fee **40€ for double handed boats, diners not included**. Entries must be submitted via our website, <https://www.rbrc.be/nl/kalender?oper=inschrijvingsformulier,wedstrijd=1306>

The warning signal for each succeeding race will be made as soon as practicable. No first warning signal will be made after 17:00. Prize giving in Duinbergen, followed by a diner and party.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES AND FORMAT

A total of maximum 4 races are scheduled.

Two different courses will be foreseen : 1 course for the C1-C3 class and 1 course for the Hobie Cat 15 class

4. CLASS FLAG

For the C1 & C3 Class : The Papy's Gang flag.
For the HC15 Class : Q flag (yellow)

5. MARKS

All marks of the course will be large inflatable yellow buoys (+ orange for the HC15 class)
The starting marks will be the RC Signal boat at the starboard end and a black buoy at the port end
The finishing marks will be the RC Signal boat at the starboard end and a white buoy at the port end.

6. SCORING

The regatta will be scored as provided in RRS Appendix A4.1 using the Low Point System. All races (less any discards) will count for overall points.
When 4 or more races have been completed, the worst score will be excluded.

7. SAFETY REGULATIONS

THE FOLLOWING MUST BE CARRIED ON BOARD:

- Life jackets / 1 per person
- 1 working mobile phone per boat

Complementary to the Class Rules – Safety Equipment - all boats must be equipped with one flare for each crew member and 30 m cord.

A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible.

8. PRIZES

Several prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the race organisation.
The Papy's Race Trophy 2026 will be awarded to the first boat in the overall ranking C1+C3 class.
Special prizes are foreseen for:

- the first 3 places in the overall ranking.
- the first 5 places most funniest "**Under Construction**" boat.
- the first Mamy's team,
- the first family crew.
- the oldest combined crew (for the boat with maximum 2 people on board).
- the first combined crew +80 (for the boat with maximum 2 people on board).
- the first combined crew +90 (for the boat with maximum 2 people on board).
- the first combined crew +100 (for the boat with maximum 2 people on board).
- the first combined crew +110 (for the boat with maximum 2 people on board).

PRIZES WILL BE REWARDED ONLY TO TEAMS WHO ATTEND THE PRIZE GIVING (REPRESENTED BY THEMSELVES)

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor, each parent present or not, each coach agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, crew and their boat and their property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- g) Their boat is adequately insured.

10. INSURANCE

- Each participant shall have a current Public Liability and Third Party Property Insurance policy, including coverage when racing at the venue of the Championship, of not less than 1.500.000 € or equivalent for each boat.

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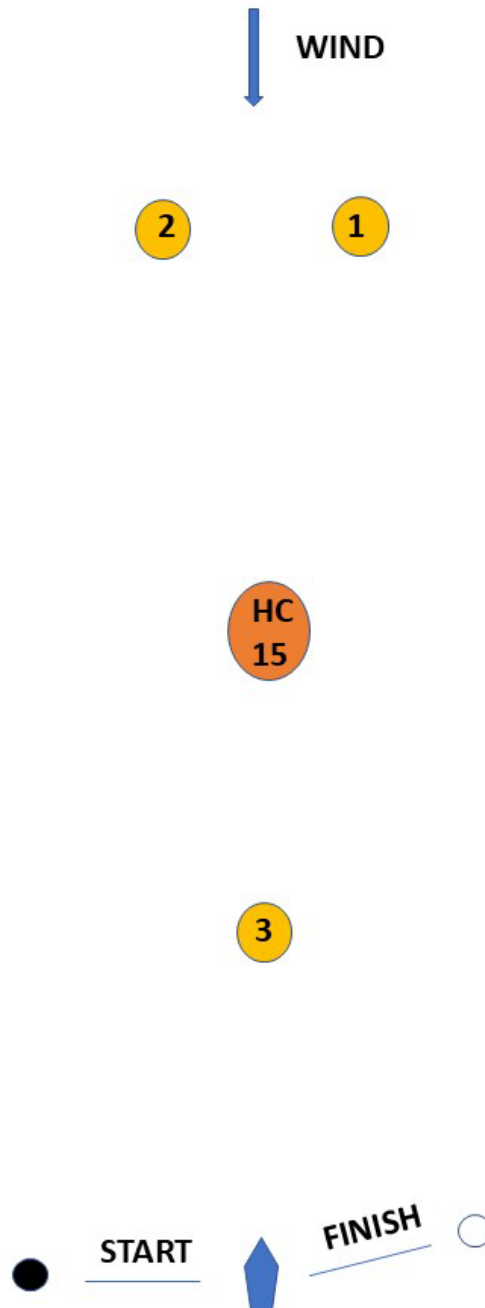
