NOTICE OF RACE

1. Organising Authority

The Organising authorities are the Royal Belgian Sailing Club (RBSC).

2. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by:

The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS).

The prescriptions of the national authority (KBYV-FRBY) will apply.

A boat, while racing, may display a national ensign or club burgee. This changes the prescription of the KBYV/FRBY 77.

The rules as defined in the Equipment Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (ERS) and any amendments.

The Notice of Race.

The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located on the windows of the clubhouse "De Windroos".

3. Advertising

This Event is designed as a Category "C" event in accordance with RRS Appendix 1 - ISAF Advertising Code, Regulation 20. The forward 25% part of the hull on each side of all participating boats shall only display advertising chosen (and required to be displayed) by that event organizer.

4. Eligibility and Entry

4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Optimist class.

5. Fees

Payment of entry has to be made at registration.

Entry fee is 15 euro/sailor and includes a diner and a drink for all sailors.

7. Venue

The Racing Area is the Damslootmeer Heusden. The Regatta Site is the **RBSC Heusden – Stapsteenweg 50, 9070 Heusden.**

8. Scoring

- 7.1 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series
- 7.2 (a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores
- (b) When 4 or 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. Prizes

A prize is foreseen for the top 3, when present at the prize giving. There will also be a raffle

11. Right to use Names and Likeness

In sailing this event a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time and at their discretion, any motion or still pictures, and live, taped or film television and any other reproductions of him/her during the period of the regatta in which the competitor competes and in all material related to the regatta without any compensation.

11. Disclaimer of liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta
